Dear Valued Customer.

Two federal courts have now struck down tariff actions taken under the International Emergency Economic Powers Act (IEEPA), with major implications for importers.

- On May 28, the U.S. Court of International Trade (CIT) issued a
 permanent injunction, blocking IEEPA tariffs on China, Canada,
 and Mexico, including the 10% reciprocal tariffs. The government
 has 10 days to implement the injunction and has already filed an
 appeal.
- On May 29, the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia went further. In a sweeping opinion, the court declared that IEEPA does not grant tariff authority at all. While this decision applies only to the plaintiffs in that case, it creates a legal split and further clouds the future of IEEPA-based tariffs.











What This Means for You

At this time, nothing is final.

While both rulings challenge the legality of the IEEPA tariffs, collection is still active pending the appeal process and further guidance from U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP).

Until CBP issues new directives or the courts provide further clarification, importers should continue to comply with existing tariff requirements — including payment of applicable duties.

Our Commitment

We are actively monitoring the situation and maintaining direct communication with trade counsel and industry bodies. As soon as CBP guidance or court orders affect your obligations, we will alert you immediately.

For now, we remain in a holding pattern.
